#### ORDER OF THE DIVISION

### BY THE DIVISION:

This case came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on October 8, 1998, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this <u>21st</u> day of October, 1998, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner.

### FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice has been given and the Division has jurisdiction of this case and its subject matter.
- (2) The applicant, Merrion Oil & Gas Corporation ("Merrion"), seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Basin-Dakota Pool underlying Lots 1 through 4 and the S/2 N/2 (N/2 equivalent) of Section 5, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in order to form a standard 293.68-acre gas spacing and proration unit for this pool.
- (3) This unit is to be dedicated to Merrion's proposed Fifield Com. Well No. 1-E (API No. 30-045-29517) to be drilled at a standard gas well location 1562 feet from the North line and 886 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 5.
  - (4) Prior to the hearing, the applicant requested this matter be dismissed.
  - (5) Dismissal of this case should therefore be granted.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Case No. 11988 is hereby dismissed.
