DAVID H. ARRINGTON OIL & GAS, INC. ("ARRINGTON"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application pursuant to the provisions of NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-17, (1978), for an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation, Townsend-Morrow Gas Pool, in Lots 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16 for all formations developed on 320-acre spacing, in Lots 11, 12, 13 and 14 for all formations developed on 160-acre spacing, in Lots 13 and 14 for all formations developed on 80-acre spacing, and Lot 14 for all formations developed on 40-acre spacing in Section 3, Township 16 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, and in support thereof states:

1. Arrington is a working interest owner in said Section 3 and has the right to drill thereon.

2. Arrington proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing or proration units to its Parachute Hopper Well No. 1 to be drilled at a standard location 3510 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the West line of said Section 3, to a depth sufficient to test any and all formations to the base of the Morrow formation, Townsend-Morrow Gas Pool.

3. Arrington has sought and been unable to obtain either voluntary agreement for

pooling or farmout from those interest owners in these spacing or proration units identified on Exhibit A to this application.

4. Said pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.

5. In order to permit the Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all mineral interests should be pooled, and David H. Arrington Oil & Gas, Inc. should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.

WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on June 25, 1998 and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order pooling the lands, including provisions designating Arrington operator of these spacing and proration units, and authorizing Arrington to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well, its costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, including overhead charges, imposing a risk factor for the risk assumed by Arrington in drilling, completing and equipping the well.
