



Applicant is a working interest owner in the Section 31, Township 20 ½ South, Range 22 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, and proposes to drill a well to the Morrow formation, Undesignated Little Box Canyon-Morrow Gas Pool, at an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the West line of said Section 31.
2. Applicant seeks an exception to Rule 104 C(2)(b) of the General Rules and Regulations of the Oil Conservation Division to permit the drilling of this well at this unorthodox gas well location.
3. All of irregular Section 31 should be dedicated to the well.
