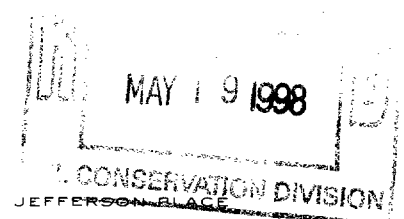

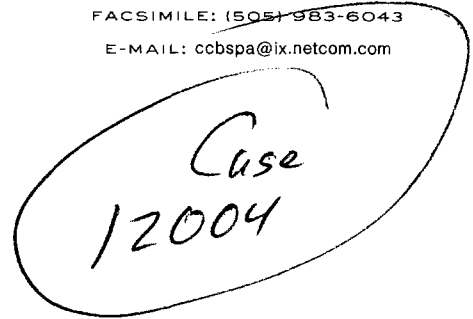

Wilson & Barr Oil and Gas Exploration hereby objects to the unorthodox gas well location proposed by Stevens and Tull, Inc. for the Sweet Thing Federal Unit Well No. 2 which it proposes to drill 660 feet from the North and West lines of Section 36, Township 20½ South, Range 21 East, NMPM Eddy County, New Mexico.
