Dear Ms. Wrotenbery:

On behalf of Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C. ("Nearburg") and in accordance with the provisions of the referenced order (copy enclosed), I am requesting a 60-day extension to the commencement date for subject well and in support state:

(1) The order was entered effective November 18, 1998 and provided that this well shall be commenced on or before February 1, 1999;

(2) This period amounts to 74 days instead of the "normal" 90-day period;

(3) Nearburg is still negotiating a surface right of way for this well

(4) An extension to April 1, 1999 will afford Nearburg with a reasonable opportunity to complete its negotiations without incurring additional costs.
