Dear Ms. Wrotenbery:

On January 7, 1999, the Division entered Order No. R-11138 which granted the application of Shackelford Oil Company in the above-referenced case and pool all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Delaware formation under the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 3, Township 20 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This pooled unit is to be dedicated to the Tonto Federal Well No. 3 which Shackelford proposes to drill at a standard location in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 3.


Order R-11138 provides that in the event Shackelford does not commence drilling operations on or before May 15, 1999, this pooling order shall be of no further effect unless Shackelford obtains a time extension from the Division Director for good cause shown. The purpose of this letter is to request an extension of Order No. R-11138.

Shackelford Oil Company intends to drill the subject well pursuant to this compulsory pooling order but has encountered delays due to restrictions on drilling in this area during the prairie chicken booming season. It is therefore necessary for Shackelford Oil Company to request an extension of Order No. R-11138 from May 15, 1999 to August 15, 1999.
