

CASE 12104:

Application of Harvard Petroleum Corporation for compulsory pooling, Roosevelt County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all formations developed on 320-acre spacing underlying the W/2, in all formations developed on 160-acre spacing in the W/4, in all formations developed on 80-acre spacing in the E/2 SW/4 and in all formations developed on 40-acre spacing from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 5, Township 8 South, Range 37 East, Roosevelt County, New Mexico. Applicant proposes to dedicate this acreage to its #1 Williams Well to be drilled at a standard location 990 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the West line of said Section 5. Also to be considered will the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 28 miles north of Tatum, New Mexico.
