Dear Mr. Bruce:

Reference is made to the following: (i) your initial application on behalf of Santa Fe Energy Resources, Inc. ("Santa Fe") dated January 8, 1999; (ii) the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's ("Division") response by letter from Mr. Michael E. Stogner, Chief Hearing Officer/Engineer in Santa Fe, dated February 1, 1999; (iii) the records of the Division in Santa Fe including the file in Division Case No. 12131; and (iv) your letter dated March 20, 1999, with signed waivers from various off-setting operators and/or interest owners: all concerning Santa Fe's request to drill its Rio Blanco Federal Com. Well No. 2 at an unorthodox Morrow gas well location 660 feet from the South and West lines (Unit M) of Section 4, Township 23 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The S/2 of Section 4 is to be dedicated to the well in order to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for either the Undesignated North Bell Lake-Morrow Gas Pool or the Undesignated Antelope Ridge-Morrow Gas Pool.

Santa Fe's March 20, 1999 letter adequately serves as a re-submittal of this application to the Division for processing administratively under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F.

The geologic interpretation submitted with this application indicates that a well drilled at the proposed unorthodox gas well location will be at a more favorable geologic position within the Morrow formation than a well drilled at a location considered to be standard for this 320-acre unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F(2), the abovedescribed unorthodox Morrow gas well location is hereby approved. Furthermore, the administrative approval of this application negates the necessity for hearing Division Case No. 12131; therefore, Administrative Order NSL-4241 Santa Fe Energy Resources, Inc. Santa Fe's request to dismiss Case No. 12131 shall be granted.
