## **AMENDED APPLICATION**

NEARBURG EXPLORATION COMPANY, L.L.C., ("Nearburg") by its undersigned attorneys, hereby make application to the Oil Conservation Division for an order (1) creating a new pool for the production of hydrocarbons in the Strawn formation as a result of the discovery of oil and gas in the Yates Ruby ASV State Com Well No. 1 located 1650 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line in Unit H of Section 15, Township 16 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County New Mexico and (2) promulgating temporary special pool rules and regulations for this pool including provisions for 80-acre spacing and special well location requirements, and in support of this application states:

1. Nearburg is a working interest owner in the Yates Petroleum Corporation Ruby ASV State Com Well No. 1 which was recently drilled as a 12,517 foot Morrow test and has been plugged back and completed in the Strawn formation. The well is producing through the perforated interval from 11,340 feet to 11,540 feet at a current daily rate of approximately 103 barrels of oil and 88 MCF of gas in a new common source of supply in the Strawn formation and is demonstrating a steady increase in its daily production rate.

2. Nearburg requests that a new pool for the production of oil and gas be created

in the Strawn formation. The following described lands are reasonably proven to be

productive of oil and gas in paying quantities from the Strawn formation and should be

included in the original definition of the pool:

Township 16 South, Range 32 East, NMPM

Section 15: NE/4

3. Operating this pool under Statewide rules which provide for 40-acre spacing

and proration units will result in the drilling of unnecessary wells and inefficient operations.

4. Applicant seek the adoption of Special Rules and Regulations to provide for

80-acre spacing and proration units to permit wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to

quarter-quarter section line of the dedicated spacing unit.

5. Approval of this application will protect the correlative rights of each owner

in the pool by affording them the opportunity to produce their just and equitable share of the

reserves in the pool, will prevent waste of hydrocarbons and will otherwise be in the best

interest of conservation.

WHEREFORE, Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C. requests that this amended

application be set for hearing before a Division Examiner on March 18, 1999 and following

notice and hearing as required by law and the rules of the Division, that this application be

granted.
