In Case No. 12146, applicant seeks certification of a positive production response in its Caprock Maljamar Unit. In Case Nos. 12148-12150, applicant seeks to qualify three waterflood expansion projects for the recovered oil tax rate. The four cases involve the Grayburg-San Andres formations in the area of Township 17 South, Ranges 31-33 East, NMPM. In each case, applicant has substantially expanded waterflood projects (initially begun 30 years ago) by drilling additional producing and injection wells, which have significantly increased the amount of oil which will be recovered from the reservoir.
