APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an exception to Division Rules 303.B and 309-B to permit approval of surface and lease commingling of Red Lake Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool and Northeast Red Lake Glorieta-Yeso Pool<sup>1</sup> production from two federal leases covering the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , and SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 35, Township 17 South, Range 27 East, NMPM. Applicant is the sole working interest owner in the leases, while overriding royalty ownership varies. Each well will be tested on a monthly basis for purposes of allocation of production.
