APPLICATION OF CHI ENERGY, INC. FOR COMPULSORY POOLING, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

Chi Energy, Inc. applies for an order pooling all mineral interests from the top of the Wolfcamp formation to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the E% of Section 19, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states:

- 1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the E% of said Section 19, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill its Greenstone Fed. Com. Well No. 1 at the following unorthodox gas well location:

Surface location: 480 feet from the South line

and 1650 feet from the East

line

Bottomhole location: Same as surface location or 760

feet from the South line and

1650 feet from the East line

(The unorthodox location is the subject of a separate case set for the April 1, 1999 Division hearing.) The well will be drilled to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation, and the E½ of Section 19 will be dedicated to the well for all pools or formations spaced on 320 acres, including the Undesignated Quail Ridge-Morrow Gas Pool.

3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the E% of Section 19 for the purposes set forth herein.

- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the E½ of Section 19, pursuant to N.M. Stat. Ann. § 70-2-17 (1996 Supp.).
- 5. The pooling of all mineral interests underlying the E½ of Section 19, as set forth above, will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that, after notice and hearing,
the Division enter its order:

- A. Pooling all mineral interests in the E% of Section 19, from the top of the Wolfcamp formation to the base of the Morrow formation;
- B. Designating applicant as operator of the well;
- C. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the cost thereof among the well's working interest owners;
- D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting said rates per the COPAS accounting procedure; and
- E. Setting a penalty for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.
