



Enclosed is a copy of an application for administrative approval of an unorthodox gas well location, filed with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division by Chi Energy, Inc., regarding the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 19, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

This application was filed on February 15, 1999, and the Division subsequently requested that we notify the lessees of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 29 of the application. 
