APPLICATION

Chi Energy, Inc. applies for an order pooling all mineral interests from 2035 feet below the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 8, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of said Section 8, and has the right to drill a well thereon.

2. Applicant proposes to drill its Silver Streak State Com. Well No. 1, at an unorthodox location 1400 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the East line of Section 8,<sup>1</sup> to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation, and seeks to dedicate the following acreage to the well:

(a) The N $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 8 for all pools or formations developed on 320 acre spacing, including the Undesignated Dog Canyon-Strawn Gas Pool;

(b) The NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8 for all pools or formations developed on 160 acre spacing; and

(c) The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8 for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing.

3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of

Section 8 for the purposes set forth herein.

4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the N½ of Section 8, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17 (1996).

5. Applicant requests that Chi Operating, Inc. be designated operator of the well.

6. The pooling of all mineral interests underlying the N½ of Section 8, as set forth above, will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

**WHEREFORE**, Applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. Pooling all mineral interests in the N½ of Section 8, from 2035 feet below the surface to the base of the Morrow formation;
- B. Designating Chi Operating, Inc. as operator of the well;
- C. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the cost thereof among the well's working interest owners;
- D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting said rates per the COPAS accounting procedure;

E. Setting a penalty for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in drilling the well; and

F. Granting such further relief as the Division deems proper.

Case 12188 : Application of Chi Energy, Inc. for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from 2035 feet below the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the following described acreage in Section 8, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, and in the following manner: The N $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8 to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within said vertical extent, including the Undesignated Dog Canyon-Strawn Gas Pool; the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8 to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 160-acre spacing within said vertical extent; and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8 to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 40 acres within said vertical extent. Said units are to be dedicated to the applicant's Silver Streak State Com. Well No. 1, to be drilled at an unorthodox location 1400 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the East line of said Section 8. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Chi Operating, Inc. as operator of the well, and a charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
