STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

OPPONENT

Applicant seeks an unorthodox gas well location for a well 1980 feet FNL and 660 feet FWL of Section 4, Township 17 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, to test the Morrow Formation. The N½ of Section 4 will be dedicated to the proposed well along with an existing well in the NE¼ of Section 4.

Santa Fe Snyder Corporation ("Santa Fe") owns an overriding royalty in the S½ of Section 4 (operated by OXY USA Inc.), and also owns a working interest in the NE¼SE¼ of offsetting Section 5.

Simultaneous dedication adversely affects Santa Fe because there will be only one well in the S½ of Section 4 competing for reserves with two wells in the N½ of Section 4. In addition, the unorthodox location encroaches upon Santa Fe's acreage in the S½ of Section 5.
