Craig H. Sluetz, being duly sworn upon his oath, deposes and states:

1. I am over the age of 18, and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein.

2. I am an employee of Applicant, and I am familiar with drilling and operational matters pertaining to the proposed La Plata Well No. 7-1, which is a proposed 2000 foot Fruitland Coal test well.

3. Applicant's proposed overhead rates for the proposed well are \$4000/month for a drilling well and \$400/month for a producing well.


4. The proposed overhead rates are reasonable, and are comparable to those charged by applicant and other operators in this area of San Juan County.

5. Overhead rates for Fruitland Coal wells are higher than for other shallow wells in San Juan County because of the large amounts of water which must be disposed of, and due to expenses related to gas compression.
