

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Case 17206 : **Application of Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C. for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico.** Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the following described acreage in Section 24, Township 19 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, and in the following manner: The E $\frac{1}{2}$ to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within said vertical extent, including the Undesignated East Gem-Morrow Gas Pool; the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 160-acre spacing within said vertical extent; and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 40 acre spacing within said vertical extent, including the Undesignated East Gem-Delaware Pool, Undesignated East Gem-Bone Spring Pool, and Undesignated East Gem-Strawn Pool. Said units are to be dedicated to applicant's Sagebrush 24 Fed. Com. Well No. 1, to be located at an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line (Unit A) of said Section 24. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Nearburg Producing Company as operator of the well, and a charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. Said unit is located approximately 4 miles northeast of Loco Hills, New Mexico.
