1 WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at
2 9:00 a.m.:

3 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Good morning. My clock
4 says it's nine o'clock, so we'll get started.

5 This is a hearing of the Oil Conservation
6 Commission. It's nine o'clock a.m. on Thursday, August
7 12th, 1999. We're here at the Oil Conservation Division's
8 conference room in Santa Fe, New Mexico.

9 I'm Lori Wrotenbery, I'm serving as Chairman of
10 the Oil Conservation Commission.

11 To my right is Commissioner Jami Bailey, she's
12 representing Land Commissioner Ray Powell on the
13 Commission.

14 To my left is Dr. Robert Lee, Commissioner.

15 We also have Florene Davidson, the Commission
16 secretary, the Commission's legal counsel, and Steve
17 Brenner will be recording the meeting for us here today.

18 We have a large agenda this month. In fact,
19 we're scheduled to meet every Thursday and Friday for the
20 rest of the month in order to cover it. The bulk of that
21 time will be spent on two contested cases we have pending
22 before the Commission, but we are going to start out and
23 try to take care of a few of the other matters that were
24 docketed for the Commission's hearing this month.

25 First of all -- Let's just go through those

1 pretty quickly here. First of all, we've got the minutes
2 of the Oil Conservation Commission hearing held on July
3 15th, 1999. I believe, Commissioners, you've had a chance
4 to review a draft of the minutes?

5 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes.

6 COMMISSIONER LEE: Yes.

7 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Do I hear a motion to adopt
8 the minutes?

9 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: I move that we adopt the
10 minutes.

11 COMMISSIONER LEE: Second.

12 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: All in favor say "Aye".

13 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye.

14 COMMISSIONER LEE: Aye.

15 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Aye. And I'll sign those
16 on behalf of the Commission.

19 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Secondly, we have Case
20 Number 12,225. The Oil Conservation called this matter to
21 consider proposed allowables, gas allowables, for the
22 prorated gas pools in New Mexico for the period October,
23 1999, to March, 2000.

24 Along with the docket for this particular
25 hearing, we sent out a memo to all producers, purchasers

1 and transporters of gas from all prorated gas pools in New
2 Mexico with the proposed allowable factors for the October,
3 1999, through March, 2000, period. We received no comments
4 on those proposed factors.

5 We have prepared an order adopting those factors.
6 I believe the Commissioners have had a chance to review
7 that order?

8 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I intend
9 to sign it.

10 COMMISSIONER LEE: (Nods)

11 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Then I'll entertain a
12 motion to adopt this order of the Commission.

13 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: I so move.

14 COMMISSIONER LEE: Second.

15 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: All in favor say "Aye".

16 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye.

17 COMMISSIONER LEE: Aye.

18 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Aye.
