WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 1:30 p.m.: EXAMINER ASHLEY: At this time the Division calls 3 Case 12,280, Application of Oil Conservation Division for 4 5 an order requiring Rault Petroleum Corporation to plug four wells in Lincoln, De Baca and Chaves Counties, New Mexico. 6 7 Call for appearances. 8 MR. CARROLL: May it please the Examiner, my name is Rand Carroll, appearing on behalf of the Oil 9 10 Conservation Division. I have one witness. 11 EXAMINER ASHLEY: Any additional appearances? 12 (Thereupon, the witness was sworn.) 13 MIKE STUBBLEFIELD (Present by telephone), 14 the witness herein, after having been first duly sworn upon 15 his oath, was examined and testified as follows: 16 DIRECT EXAMINATION BY MR. CARROLL: 17 Mr. Stubblefield, would you please state your 18 Q. 19 name for the record? 20 My name is Mike Stubblefield. Α. And Mike, who do you work for, and what is your 21 Q. 22 job with that employer? I work for the Oil Conservation Division, the 23 Α. 24 Department of Energy and Minerals, and I am currently a 25 Field Representative II, which is a supervisory position.

And Mr. Stubblefield, as a Field Rep II are part 1 Q. of your duties the supervision of the plugging of abandoned 2 3 oil and gas wells? Yes, sir. Α. 4 Mr. Stubblefield, have you had occasion to 5 Q. testify before this Division before regarding the plugging 6 of wells in your district? 7 Yes, sir. 8 Α. MR. CARROLL: Mr. Examiner, I offer Mike 9 10 Stubblefield as an expert in the plugging of wells in New 11 Mexico. 12 EXAMINER ASHLEY: Mr. Stubblefield is so 13 qualified. (By Mr. Carroll) Mr. Stubblefield, if you'll 14 Q. please refer to what has been marked as OCD Exhibit Numbers 15 1A through -D, could you -- First of all, the first two 16 pages of each exhibit, that constitutes your recommended 17 plugging procedure; is that correct? 18 Α. Correct. 19 20 Can you please give the Examiner a brief summary Q. 21 of the history of these wells, the current condition of 22 these wells, in your opinion, as to what should be done? 23 Α. Okay, I'll start with the Mark Isler Number 1, 24 located in M of --25 Q. That's B.

A. -- 33-3-25.

- Q. Okay, go ahead.
- A. Okay, this well was permitted in June of 1982 by Petroleum Development Corporation, and in July 2nd of 1982 was transferred to Rault Petroleum Corporation.

This well was spudded July 6th, 1982. And July 8th, 1982, 10 3/4 casing was cemented at 958. My records also show July 17th, 1982, 4-1/2-inch casing was run and cemented at 4040 foot.

October 7th, 1982, the well was completed with perforations at 3537 and 3541, and we have had no reported production on the Mark Isler Number 1.

May 2nd, 1991, a TA letter was sent to Rault Petroleum by District Supervisor Mike Williams.

January 5th, 1999 [sic], a second letter was sent certified to Rault Petroleum Corporation by Ray Smith, who was then a Field Rep II in the District, requesting the well be plugged and abandoned, and this well [sic] was returned to OCD unclaimed.

August 2nd, 1999 [sic], a letter was sent to Rand Carroll requesting the well be plugged and abandoned to protect the fresh waters of the State of New Mexico, the environment and correlative rights in the area.

And according to current information we have received -- Rault Petroleum was placed in Chapter VII

- bankruptcy by the US Bankruptcy Court on May 6th, 1985.
- the fresh water, the environment and correlative rights in the area.

And I am recommending that this well be plugged to protect

- Q. Mr. Stubblefield, is it pretty much the same story for the other three wells?
 - A. Yes, sir, it is.
 - Q. Were they drilled at approximately the same time as the Mark Isler?
 - A. No, they were drilled at various dates, Rand.
- Q. What years?

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- A. Well, let's see. That Ridge State Number 1, which is located in G of 24-1-20, was drilled May 5th of 1982. The Union State 1 was spudded July 31st, 1982 --
 - Q. So they're all drilled in 1982?
- 16 A. Yes, sir.
- 17 Q. And have any of them shown any production?
 - A. No, sir, we have no reported production on any of these wells.
 - Q. Mr. Stubblefield, you've already indicated that the Division's efforts to reach Rault Petroleum have not resulted in any contact, and we do have second-hand information that Rault Petroleum is in bankruptcy?
 - A. Correct.
 - Q. Mr. Stubblefield, are you aware if there's any

7 bond on these wells? 1 (No response) 2 Α. MR. CARROLL: Mr. Examiner, if you'll refer to 3 what has been marked OCD Exhibit Number 2 --4 5 EXAMINER ASHLEY: Okay. MR. CARROLL: -- it is the \$50,000 blanket bond 6 7 filed with the Division for Rault Petroleum Corporation. 8 Q. (By Mr. Carroll) Mr. Stubblefield, what's the current condition of these four wells? 9 10 I show them to be shut in with no reported Α. production and to be shut in and abandoned. 11 12 Q. Are there any liquids escaping to the surface? 13 Is there any equipment on the sites that can be salvaged? 14 Α. I believe there is no surface equipment that can 15 be salvaged except for probably downhole salvage from the 16 wells. And to my knowledge there is no liquid escaping to 17 the environment at this time. Mr. Stubblefield, at this time do you recommend 18 that all four of these wells be plugged and abandoned 19 20 according to the plugging procedures you recommend in order 21 to prevent waste, protect correlative rights and/or protect

A. Yes, I do.

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public health and the environment?
