The above cases involve the prolonged efforts of the interested parties to finalize the expansion of the West Lovington Strawn Unit. Gillespie, Jr. Mr. Gillespie, through Gillespie Oil, Inc. participated in the development of the Strawn formation in the area and served as Unit Operator for the WLSU.
