APPLICATION OF BURLINGTON RESOURCES OIL & GAS COMPANY TO AMEND THE SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE BASIN-DAKOTA POOL FOR PURPOSES OF CHANGING THE WELL LOCATION REQUIREMENTS, RIO ARRIBA AND SAN JUAN COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

## AMENDED ORDER

## BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") that Order No. R-10987-B, dated June 30, 2000, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- (1) Subparagraph (F) of Finding Paragraph No. (8) on pages 5 and 6 of Order No. R-10987-B is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:
  - (F) On May 22, 1979, by Order No. R-1670-V issued in Case No. 6533. the Commission granted the application of El Paso Natural Gas Company for an option second well (infill well) on a 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit with both the original and infill well to be located in opposite quarter sections and with wells to be located not closer than 790 feet to any outer boundary of the quarter section on which the well is located, and no closer than 130 feet to a governmental quarter-quarter section or subdivision inner boundary. This order reintroduced a distance-between-wells requirement, but changed the previous distance of 1320 feet to 920 feet.
- (2) The corrections set forth in this order shall be entered retroactively as of June 30, 2000.
