

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to SDX Resources, Inc.'s (SDX's) letter of December 13, 1999, regarding the drainage area of SDX's Federal Jalmat Com No. 1 well, in which letter it was stated:

"We have our own data and do not concur with your calculations."

As you will recall, in our second letter to SDX of December 10, 1999, we did <u>not</u> ask SDX if it had its own drainage area data, or if SDX concurred with our computed drainage area value of 217 acres for the Federal Jalmat Com No. 1 well. We very well realize that it is SDX's position that SDX does not concur with our estimated drainage area value of 217 acres for the Federal Jalmat Com No. 1 well.

In our second letter of December 10, 1999, we asked SDX for its computed drainage area value for the Federal Jalmat Com No. 1 well, since a second well on the 120-acre Federal Jalmat Com

proration unit is not necessary, if the demonstrated drainage area of the current well is in excess of the 120-acre proration unit size, which appears to be the case for the Federal Jalmat Com No. 1 well.

Obviously, if SDX's Federal Jalmat Com No. 1 well has been draining more than its assigned proration unit, potential waste has <u>not</u> been occurring, but the drilling of a second well on the subject 120-acre proration unit would most certainly negatively impact upon the correlative rights of offset operators. In light of SDX's proposed Federal Jalmat Com No. 2 well, I would think that SDX would want to make known its computed drainage area value for the Federal Jalmat Com No. 1 well, unless SDX's computed drainage area value for the Federal Jalmat Com No. 1 well is also in excess of the 120 acres that is assigned by SDX to the subject well.

As stated in our first letter of December 10, 1999, "...it is essential that infill drilling applications go through a public hearing process, when opposition exists, with a finding of fact and order being rendered by the NMOCD only after all of the facts and data have been presented by both sides." Although SDX may have its own drainage area data, it is apparent that SDX does not want to make its calculations known, either in writing nor at a public hearing.
