Marathon has received and reviewed your letter dated December 15, 1999 pertaining to the above referenced. At the present time Marathon is agreeable to the following:

1. Joining Ameristate and the other owners in Section 13 in forming a 640 acre working interest unit to explore the Permian and the Pennsylvanian formation.
2. Joining Ameristate in the formation of a 480 acre working interest unit comprised of the E/2 and SW/4 of Section 13. Assuming Phillips/Southwestern participate in the E/2 this would give Marathon and Ameristate et al each a 43.75% working interest in the E/2 and 50% working interest in the SW/4.
3. Participate in the referenced well as to our interest in the E/2 of Section 13 (25%).
