3           EXAMINER CATANACH: Call the hearing to order  
4           this morning for Docket Number 16-00.

5           Call the continuances and dismissals first.

6           (Off the record)

7           EXAMINER CATANACH: At this time I'm going to  
8           call Case 12,393, which is the Application of Santa Fe  
9           Snyder Corporation for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New  
10          Mexico.

11          I believe this case was previously heard by  
12          Examiner Stogner.

13          Are there any appearances at this time?

14          MR. KELLAHIN: Mr. Examiner, I'm Tom Kellahin of  
15          the Santa Fe law firm of Kellahin and Kellahin, appearing  
16          on behalf of this Applicant, Santa Fe Snyder Corporation.

17          MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce appearing on  
18          behalf of Southwestern Energy Production Company. This  
19          matter was heard in conjunction with Case 12,407. I would  
20          ask that this case be called -- or I should say at this  
21          time Case 12,407, because certain actions by the Bureau of  
22          Land Management should be dismissed. Or, excuse me,  
23          12,423.

24          EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, let me go ahead and  
25          call Case 12,423, which is the Application of Southwestern

1 Energy Production Company for compulsory pooling and an  
2 unorthodox oil well location, Lea County, New Mexico.

3 Do I have additional appearances in either one of  
4 these cases?

5 Okay, gentlemen, statements in these cases?

6 MR. BRUCE: Really, at this time, Mr. Examiner,  
7 like I said, please dismiss Case 12,423, which is my  
8 client's Application, and I think Mr. Kellahin's case can  
9 be taken under advisement.

10 MR. KELLAHIN: That's my understanding of what is  
11 to occur, Mr. Catanach.

12 Mr. Catanach, Mr. Stogner asked for me to submit  
13 a proposed order, and I will do that this morning.

14 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay. There being nothing  
15 further in Case 12,393, that case will be taken under  
16 advisement. And at the request of the Applicants, Case  
17 Number 12,423 will be dismissed.


