

**APPLICATION**

CONCHO RESOURCES, INC. ("Concho"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application pursuant to the provisions of N.M.Stat.Ann. § 70-2-17, (1978), for an order pooling all mineral interests in all formations developed on 320-acre spacing in the W/2 which includes but is not necessarily limited to the South Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool, in all formations developed on 160-acre spacing in the NW/4, and in all formations developed on 80-acre spacing under the W/2 NW/4 of Section 14, Township 23 South, Range 26 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states:

1. Concho is a working interest owner in the W/2 of Section 14 and has the right to drill thereon.
2. Applicant proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing or proration units to its Beretta 14 State Com Well No. 1 to be drilled at a standard location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line said Section 14, to a depth sufficient to test any and all formations from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation. The primary objective in the well will be the Morrow formation, South Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool Gas

Pool.

3. Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain either voluntary agreement for pooling or farmout from certain interest owners in the subject spacing units identified on Exhibit A to this application.

4. Said pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.

5. In order to permit the Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all mineral interests should be pooled, and Concho Resources, Inc. should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.


WHEREFORE, Concho Resources, Inc. requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on June 15, 2000 and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order:

- A. pooling all mineral interests in the subject spacing and proration units,
- B. designating Concho Resources, Inc. operator of these units and the well to be drilled thereon,
- C. authorizing Concho to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well,
- D. approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures, and
- E. imposing a penalty for the risk assumed by the Applicant in drilling and

completing the well against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the well.

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in all formations developed on 320-acre spacing in the W/2 including but not limited to the South Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool, in all formations developed on 160-acre spacing in the NW/4, and in all formations developed on 80-acre spacing in the W/2 NW/4 of Section 14 Township 23 South, Range 26 East, NMPM. Said units are to be dedicated to its Beretta 14 State Com Well No. 1 to be drilled at a standard location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line of said Section 14 to a depth sufficient to test all formations from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation, South Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool.
