CATANACH, Hearing Examiner, on Thursday, June 15th, 2000, at the New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, Porter Hall, 2040 South Pacheco, Santa Fe, New Mexico, Steven T. Brenner, Certified Court Reporter No. 7 for the State of New Mexico.

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1 WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 2 10:01 a.m.: 3 4 EXAMINER CATANACH: At this time we will call 5 Case 12,433, which is the Application of the Oil 6 7 Conservation Division for an order requiring U-Mex, Inc., 8 to properly plug two wells, Chaves County, New Mexico. 9 I will call for appearances in this case. MS. HEBERT: May it please the Examiner, my name 10 is Lyn Hebert. 11 I'm appearing on behalf of the Oil Conservation 12 Division, and I have one witness. 13 EXAMINER CATANACH: Call for additional 14 15 appearances. 16 There are none. 17 Your witness is appearing today by telephone; is that correct, Ms. Hebert? 18 MS. HEBERT: Yes, he is. 19 20 EXAMINER CATANACH: May I get Mr. Stubblefield to stand and be sworn in at this time? 21 22 (Thereupon, the witness was sworn.) 23 MS. HEBERT: Mr. Examiner, if it please the 24 Examiner that Mr. Stubblefield be sworn for all six of the 25 cases that will be heard today in this matter.

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1	EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay.
2	MIKE STUBBLEFIELD (Present by Telephone),
3	the witness herein, after having been first duly sworn upon
4	his oath, was examined and testified as follows:
5	DIRECT EXAMINATION
6	BY MS. HEBERT:
7	Q. Mr. Stubblefield, would you state your name for
8	the record and tell us where you work and what you do
9	there?
10	A. Yes, ma'am. My name is Mike Stubblefield. I'm a
11	Field Rep II in the Artesia District Office.
12	Q. And are part of your duties with the Oil
13	Conservation Division the supervision of plugging of
14	abandoned oil and gas wells?
15	A. Yes, ma'am.
16	Q. And how long have you worked in this capacity?
17	A. For the last four years.
18	MS. HEBERT: Mr. Examiner, I offer Mr.
19	Stubblefield as an expert in the plugging of wells in New
20	Mexico.
21	EXAMINER CATANACH: Mr. Stubblefield is so
22	qualified.
23	Q. (By Ms. Hebert) Mr. Stubblefield, will you
24	please turn to what's been marked as Exhibit 1 in Case
25	Number 12,433?

1	A. Okay.
2	Q. And on Exhibit 1, is this a record of the well
3	records for this well, and this is the Well, could you
4	just state what well this is?
5	EXAMINER CATANACH: Excuse me, could I have a set
6	of exhibits, please?
7	THE WITNESS: This would be for the Cannon Fee
8	Number 5, Lyn.
9	Q. (By Ms. Hebert) And does part of Exhibit 1
10	contain your recommendations for the plugging of this
11	Cannon Fee well?
12	A. Yes, ma'am.
13	Q. And is it your recommendation that this well be
14	plugged according to these procedures?
15	A. Yes, ma'am, it is.
16	Q. As to the other well that's described in Exhibit
17	1, what is the name of that well?
18	A. The Cannon Fee Number 4.
19	Q. And both of the wells that are described in
20	Exhibit Number 1 are in Chaves County; is that correct, Mr.
21	Stubblefield?
22	A. Yes, ma'am, that is correct.
23	Q. And is there also a plugging procedure
24	recommended for this well?
25	A. Yes, there is.

Q. Is it in the best interest of preventing waste
that both of these wells be plugged as recommended in these
exhibits?
A. Yes, ma'am, I do believe it is.
Q. Okay, thank you. Going to Exhibit Number 2, is
that a \$50,000 plugging bond taken in the name of UMEX,
Incorporated?
A. Yes, ma'am, it is.
MS. HEBERT: Mr. Examiner, Exhibit Number 3 is
the affidavit regarding the notice that has been given in
this matter, and there has been no contact from any of the
parties that were notified regarding plugging of these
wells.
And with that, we conclude our presentation on
the plugging of the two wells in Chaves County that were
operated by U-Mex, Incorporated.
EXAMINATION
BY EXAMINER CATANACH:
Q. Mr. Stubblefield, it looks like these two Cannon
wells are fairly shallow wells?
A. Yes, sir, they are, Dave.
Q. Drilled down to 675 feet or so? Is that your
understanding, or did they drill actually down to the San
Andres?
A. No, Dave, I show they drilled down to Well,

1	let me pull this file here.
2	The Cannon Fee 5 was drilled to 684 foot, where
3	7-inch casing was set, and drilling operations were
4	abandoned at that time on that well.
5	Q. Okay.
6	A. The Cannon Fee 4 was drilled down to a depth of
7	675 foot, where 7-inch casing was ran and cemented.
8	And at that time drilling operations were
9	suspended on the well.
10	Q. Okay. As far as you know, nothing has been done
11	to these wells since 1989?
12	A. No, Dave, not after the drilling operations were
13	suspended.
14	Q. Okay. Mr. Stubblefield, do you know if U-Mex
15	operates any other wells in your district?
16	A. I have queried our databases and have found no
17	other wells in operation.
18	EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay. Let me ask Ms. Hebert,
19	do you intend on taking action with regards to this
20	plugging bond?
21	MS. HEBERT: Yes, Mr. Examiner, the Division
22	will, of course, let a contract. And depending upon the
23	cost, the actual cost, of plugging the two wells, a demand
24	will be made for the actual cost of plugging the wells on
25	the \$50,000 bond.

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EXAMINER CATANACH: But we don't know at this 1 point whether or not these are the only two wells covered 2 under this bond, or do we know that? 3 MS. HEBERT: We don't know that. It will not be 4 5 released if there are other wells that are covered. EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, that's what I was 6 7 trying to get to. Okay. EXAMINER CATANACH: And this notice was received 8 by the party, I take it, as evidenced from the --9 MS. HEBERT: Yes, we received the green card. If 10 I can look who signed for it... 11 EXAMINER CATANACH: It looks like a Candace --12 13 I'm not sure what the last name is. Barela, possibly. 14 MS. HEBERT: Barela, it looks like Barela. That 15 was signed off on behalf of U-Mex when it was sent to the 16 Roswell address. 17 EXAMINER CATANACH: Which is their last known address? 18 MS. HEBERT: Which was the last known address. 19 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay. 20 21 MS. HEBERT: And we've had no communication from them. 22 23 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay. I have nothing further in this case. 24 25 Anything further, Ms. Hebert?

MS. HEBERT: No, nothing further. EXAMINER CATANACH: There being nothing further in this case, Case 12,433 will be taken under advisement.
