WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 10:36 a.m.: EXAMINER CATANACH: At this time I will call Case 3 12,438, the Application of the Oil Conservation Division 4 for an order requiring Salado Operating, L.L.C., to 5 properly plug four wells, Eddy County, New Mexico. 6 7 Call for appearances in this case. 8 MS. HEBERT: Mr. Examiner, Lyn Hebert on behalf 9 of the Oil Conservation Division. 10 I have one witness, Mike Stubblefield. He has been sworn and been accepted as an expert in Case Number 11 12,433. 12 EXAMINER CATANACH: Call for additional 13 appearances? 14 There are no additional appearances in this case, 15 16 and the record shall reflect that Mr. Stubblefield has been 17 properly sworn and qualified as a witness in this case. 18 MS. HEBERT: Mr. Examiner, I hand you the exhibits in this case on the four wells. 19 20 MIKE STUBBLEFIELD (Present by Telephone), the witness herein, after having been first duly sworn upon 21 22 his oath, was examined and testified as follows: DIRECT EXAMINATION 23 BY MS. HEBERT: 24 25 Mr. Stubblefield --Q.

A. Yes, ma'am.

Q. -- Exhibit Number 1A -- I believe these have been marked 1A -- I'm not sure why this was marked 1A, I can't seem to find a 1B. These are marked slightly different.

The exhibit is 1A, and then we have an Exhibit 1B, which is the well plugging bond, and then the affidavit is marked as 1C.

In Exhibit Number 1A, Mr. Stubblefield, would you give us a description of the four wells, and with each one would you give us the brief history of when it was drilled and the last production?

A. Yes, ma'am. The first well is the East Henshaw
Unit Tract 10 Number 4. The records show this well to have
been spudded June 12th, 1961. The records show the well to
have had 2-7/8 casing run and cemented to 3140, and last
production on the ONGARD system was August of 1996.

My second well is East Henshaw Unit Tract 15

Number 6. Records show this well to have been spudded

September 30, 1961, and 2.875-inch casing was run and

cemented at 3018 foot, and we have last production reported

on ONGARD as September of 1996.

My third well is East Henshaw Unit Tract 9 Number
7. Records show this well to have been spudded October
29th of 1961, and 2.75-inch casing was run and set and
cemented at 3007 foot. This well was completed with

perforations from 2968-2970, and we have no production report on the ONGARD database system.

My final well is the East Henshaw Unit Tract 24

Number 1. Records show this well to have been spudded

August 25th of 1961. 2.875-inch casing was ran and

cemented at 3075 foot, and we have no reported production

on the ONGARD system.

- Q. Mr. Stubblefield, for each of these four wells do you recommend that they be plugged to protect the waters of New Mexico, and have you included a recommended plugging procedure at the last pages of each of the groups of Exhibit 1A?
 - A. Yes, ma'am, I do, and I have.
- Q. Thank you. Moving on to Exhibit Number 4 [sic], are those the four one-well plugging bonds for these four wells?
 - A. Yes, ma'am, they are.
- Q. And those bonds were written by Underwriters
 Indemnity Company; is that correct?
 - A. That is correct.

MS. HEBERT: Mr. Examiner, Exhibit 1C is the affidavit regarding the notice that was sent in this matter. There was a green card returned from the Underwriters Indemnity Company, and I'm looking for some indication of the notice that was provided to the operating

1 company. The last known address was Hobbs, New Mexico, and 2 Exhibit 1C doesn't contain either a return envelope or a 3 receipt of a green card. The Hobbs address was the only 5 address that was in the file for this operator. EXAMINER CATANACH: So Ms. Hebert, we did attempt 6 7 to send that to the Hobbs and --MS. HEBERT: We did send it, and we have not 8 9 received anything in return from the Post Office, which is 10 unusual, but... EXAMINER CATANACH: So we don't know at this 11 point whether or not they received it or not? 12 13 MS. HEBERT: No, we don't. EXAMINER CATANACH: Would you suggest any remedy 14 for this? 15 MS. HEBERT: We could carry this case over. 16 Ιf 17 it please the Examiner, we request that we carry this case over. We will send again notice to both the underwriters 18 and to the operating company at the last known address. I 19 20 don't know what else the Division can do, other than that. 21 EXAMINER CATANACH: Do you suggest we continue 22 this for four weeks, Ms. Hebert? 23 MS. HEBERT: I would request four weeks, yes. 24 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, that would give you 21 25 days to try and notify this party again.

1	We'll go ahead and continue the case to July
2	13th.
3	MS. HEBERT: Okay, thank you.
4	EXAMINER CATANACH: And anything else in this
5	case?
6	MS. HEBERT: Nothing else.
7	EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, we'll continue this

9	MS. HEBERT: Thank you, that's all we have.
10	EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, there appears to be
11	nothing left on this docket to hear, so we will adjourn
12	this hearing.

14	EXAMINER CATANACH: Mike, thank you.
15	THE WITNESS: Yeah, thank you, Dave.
16	MS. HEBERT: Thank you, Mike.
