MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

NEARBURG EXPLORATION COMPANY, L.L.C. ("Nearburg"), YATES PETROLEUM CORPORATION ("Yates"), BTA OIL PRODUCERS ("BTA") and C. W. Trainer ("Trainer"), collectively referred to as "the effected operators," hereby move the Examiner for an order granting a four week continuance of hearing on the application of LG&E Natural Pipeline, L.L.C. ("LG&E") which seeks an order establishing special rules for wells drilled and completed or recompleted in the Morrow formation within its Grama Ridge Morrow Gas Storage Unit and within each 320-acre spacing unit immediately adjacent to that Unit in Lea County, New Mexico. In support of this motion the effected operators state:

- 1. LG&E seeks and order from the Division establishing special pool rules requiring operators of all newly drilled or recompleted wells in the Morrow formation within the Grama Ridge Morrow Gas Storage Unit and each 320-acre spacing unit immediately adjacent to that Unit to provide LG&E with information and data obtained during drilling, completion and production and demonstrate that such well is not interfering with LG&E's gas storage operations.
- 2. LG&E provided notice of its application to affected parties by certified mail on June 12, 2000, 20 days before the scheduled hearing.

3. LG&E's application involves complicated land, title, geological, and engineering issues which require the preparation of expert testimony and evidence which addresses substantial technical issues.

The Effected Operators Require Additional Time To Complete Discovery And Review Documents Necessary To Prepare For Hearing.

- 4. Nearburg and LG&E have recently been engaged in discussions concerning certain documents requested by Nearburg in anticipation of the hearing scheduled for June 29th.
- 5. On June 23, 2000, Nearburg contacted the legal counsel for LG&E concerning its need for data from LG&E to prepare for the hearing on this application. A list of the requested data was provided by Nearburg.
- 6. LG&E's counsel was unable to reach representatives of LG&E on June 23, 2000, concerning this request and was therefore unable to respond on that date.
- 7. Because of the impending hearing date, on June 26, 2000, Nearburg was forced to serve a subpoena seeking this data on LG&E. See Attachment A.
- 8. Nearburg remains willing to continue discussions with LG&E and to undertake informal efforts to resolve whatever differences the parties may have over production of these documents. However, there is not sufficient time before the June 29th hearing for the requested documents to be produced and reviewed by witnesses and expert witnesses who may be called to offer testimony at the hearing.
- 9. Nearburg believes that production and review of the requested documents is vital to its ability to adequately prepare for hearing.

Additional Time Is Necessary To Prepare and Coordinate Witnesses And Expert Witnesses Who Intend To Offer Testimony At The Hearing.

- 10. Undersigned counsel has recently been contacted by Yates, BTA and C.W. Trainer to also represent them in opposition to the application filed by LG&E. Each of these parties intends to present witnesses at the hearing to testify concerning the land, title, geological, and engineering issues raised by LG&E's application.
- 11. The witnesses of each of these parties also needs to review the information Nearburg has requested from LG&E.
- On June 22nd, undersigned counsel was contacted by Roy Williamson about offering 12. expert testimony on behalf of C.W. Trainer's opposition to LG&E's application. Mr. Williamson has received a large volume of data from Mr. Trainer concerning over 30 wells located to the west of the Grama Ridge Morrow Gas Storage Unit and has been retained to conduct an in depth study of the Morrow formation in the area. Trainer also needs the requested continuance because the 20 day notice period provided by Division rules provides inadequate time for the preparation of Mr. Williamson's study and related testimony.
- 13. Undersigned counsel requires additional time is prepare and coordinate the testimony of witnesses and expert witnesses for hearing.

WHEREFORE, Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C., Yates Petroleum Corporation, BTA Oil Producers and C. W. Trainer respectfully request that the Examiner enter an order continuing the hearing on this application to the July 27, 2000 Examiner hearing docket.

TO SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM TO LG&E NATURAL PIPELINE, L.L.C. IN NEW MEXICO OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION CASE 12441

PURPOSE: The purpose of this subpoena is to provide all of the information necessary for Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C. to be able to prepare its opposition to LG&E Natural Pipeline, L.L.C., in New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Case 12441.

PRODUCE THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS:

- (1) All reservoir pressure information from the date of inception of the Grama Ridge Morrow Gas Storage Unit including all bottomhole pressure tests and build-up test results, current well rates, flowing tubing pressures and choke sizes on each well within the Grama Ridge Unit and the area which is the subject of Oil Conservation Division Case 12441.
- (2) All production injection and withdrawal information for each well in the Grama Ridge Morrow Gas Storage Unit.
- (3) All well data on each well within the Grama Ridge Morrow Gas Storage Unit and the area surrounding the unit identified in LG&E's application to the Division in this case including complete well histories, work over histories and recompletion information.
- (4) All geological and reservoir engineering mapping and interpretations of the Grama Ridge Morrow Storage Unit.
- (5) All seismic data, geophysical mapping, and geophysical interpretations of the Grama Ridge Morrow Gas Storage Unit.
- (6) All data presented to the Oil Conservation Division or the New Mexico State Land Office concerning the Grama Ridge Morrow Gas Storage Unit.
- (7) All agreements related to the formation and operation of the Grama Ridge Morrow Gas Storage Unit including all unit agreements, operating agreements, Division of working interest agreements and all amendments and revisions thereto.
- (8) All documents between LG&E Natural Pipeline, L.L.C. and its predecessors in interest concerning the boundaries of the Grama Ridge Morrow Gas Storage Unit.
