## **APPLICATION**

Comes now OXY USA INC. ("OXY"), by its attorneys Kellahin & Kellahin, and applies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an order rescinding Division Order R-4949 which adopted the special pool rules for the North Burton Flats-Wolfcamp Gas Pool so that all existing and future wells and their respective spacing and proration units which are now subject to this order will be governed by the provisions of Division General Rules including Rule 104; AND in support thereof states:

(1) On January 8, 1975, the Division issued Order R-4949 which established the North Burton Flats-Wolfcamp Gas Pool and adopted special rules and regulations including:

Rule 2: the presumption that each 320-acre GPU is limited to one well (See Finding (4) of Order R-4949;

Rule 4: confining well location to being not closer than 1980 feet from the end boundary of a GPU;

Rule 5: which sets gas production limits for each GPU of 1500 MCFPD

Rules 9 to 18: which deal with prorationing of gas and assignment of allowables for the GPUs in this pool.

(2) The current boundaries for the North Burton Flats-Wolfcamp Gas Pool are as follows:

Township 20 South, Range 28 East, NMPM

Sections 3,4,9,10,11: all Section 12: W/2Sections 14,15: all Section 16: E/2Section 19: S/2Section 20: S/2Section 21: S/2Sections 22,23,28 through 33: all

(3) All wells within one mile of the current boundaries of the pool are subject to the rules for this pool.

(4) Currently, there are 14 producing gas wells dedicated to this pool, all of which are operated by Chi Operating Inc., Yates Petroleum Corporation, Vision Energy Inc., Exxon-Mobil or OXY USA Inc.

(5) OXY has determined that it is unnecessary to restrict the location or limit the production for wells in this pool as provided in Order R-4949. In addition, OXY has determined that it is no longer necessary to have special rules for these pools including those dealing with production limits (prorationing and allowables).

(6) OXY has determined that wells subject to these special rules can best be managed by reverting to the Division's statewide general rules including allowing for two gas wells per GPU as provided for in General Rule 104.

(7) Therefore, OXY requests that the special order for the North Burton Flats-Wolfcamp Gas Pool be rescinded. NMOCD Application OXY USA Inc. -Page 3-

(8) Based upon data currently available, approval of OXY's application will prevent waste, protect correlative rights and provide for the orderly development of the reservoir.

(9) In accordance with Division Rule 1207, notification of this application and request for hearing to be held on July 13, 2000 has been sent to those persons identified on Exhibit "A" attached.

Wherefore, Applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, this application be granted.
