APPLICATION OF OCEAN ENERGY RESOURCES, INC. FOR A NON-STANDARD OIL SPACING AND PRORATION UNIT, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

Ocean Energy Resources, Inc. applies for approval of a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit in the Strawn formation comprised of the NW1/SE1/4 of irregular Section 2, Township 16 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is the working interest owner in the NW¼SE¼ of Section 2, and proposes to drill its Townsend "2" State Well No. 11, at a location 1800 feet from the south line and 1650 feet from the east line of the section, to a depth sufficient to test the Strawn formation (South Big Dog-Strawn Pool). The subject pool is spaced on 80 acres.
- 2. The south two-thirds of irregular section 2 contains the following Strawn oil well units:

WellUnitField APK State Com. No. 1Lots 10 and 15Field APK State Com. No. 2Lots 8 and 9Townsend State No. 1Lot 16 and NE¼SE¼Townsend "2" State No. 5S½SE¼

The non-standard units for the Field APK State Com. Well No. 2 and Townsend State Well No. 1 were approved by Division Order No. R-10803.

3. As a result of the above well units, an 80 acre well unit cannot be formed for the proposed well, and a non-standard unit comprised of the NW%SE% of Section 2 should be approved.

4. The granting of this application will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that the Division enter its order approving the non-standard oil spacing and proration unit requested herein.
