APPLICATION OF KCS MEDALLION RESOURCES, INC. FOR COMPULSORY POOLING, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

KCS Medallion Resources, Inc. applies for an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Bone Spring formation underlying the SW4NE4 of Section 24, Township 18 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states:

1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the SW4NE4 of Section 24, and has the right to drill a well thereon.

2. Applicant proposes to drill its Shugart West Fed. 24 Well No. G-2, at an orthodox location in the SW¼NE¼ of Section 24, to a depth sufficient to test the Bone Spring formation, and seeks to dedicate the SW¼NE¼ of Section 24 to the well for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Undesignated North Shugart-Bone Spring Pool.

3. Applicant has in good faith sought the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the SW4NE4 of Section 24 for the purposes set forth herein.

4. Although Applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their acreage. Therefore, Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the SW%NE% of Section 24, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.

5. The pooling of all interests underlying the SW¼NE¼ of Section 24 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

A. Pooling all mineral interests in the SW¼NE¼ of Section24, from the surface to the base of the Bone Spring formation;

B. Designating applicant as operator of the well;

C. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the cost thereof among the well's working interest owners;

D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and

E. Setting a penalty for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.
