Dockets Nos. 4-01 and 5-01 are tentatively set for February 8, 2001 and February 22, 2001. Applications for hearing must be filed at least 23 days in advance of hearing date. The following cases will be heard by an Examiner:

J CASE 12578: $\frac{1}{2}$ Application of Cross Timbers Oil Company to Amend Division Order Nos. R-11132 and R-11132-A for simultaneous dedication and an unorthodox surface well location, San Juan County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks to amend Division Order Nos. R-11132 and R-11132-A to approve applicant's proposed Ute Indians "A" Well No. 32, to be drilled at an unorthodox surface location 560 feet from the South line and 1120 feet from the East line of Section 2, Township 31 North, Range 14 West, to be directionally drilled to a bottomhole location 1031 feet from the South line and 1656 feet from the East line of Section 2, to a depth sufficient to test the Morrison formation. Applicant further seeks to amend the orders to simultaneously dedicate the SE/4 of Section 2 to (i) the Ute Indians "A" Well Nos. 20 and 32 in the Dakota formation, and (ii) the Ute Indians "A" Well Nos. 27 and 32 in the Morrison formation. The unit is located approximately 6 miles west of La Plata, New Mexico.

CASE 12579: $\frac{2}{4}$ Application of Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the following described acreage in Section 22, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, in the following manner: the E/2 to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Undesignated Avalon-Wolfcamp Gas Pool, Undesignated Avalon-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Undesignated Avalon-Strawn Gas Pool, Undesignated Crozier Bluff-Atoka Gas Pool, and Undesignated Avalon-Morrow Gas Pool; and the NE/4 to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The units are to be dedicated to applicant's Carlsbad 22 "H" Fee Com. Well No. 2, located 1350 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 22. Also to be considered will be the cost of re-entering and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a charge for the risk involved in re-entering and completing the well. The units are located approximately 4 miles northwest of Carlsbad, New Mexico.

CASE 12580: $\frac{3}{4}$ Application of Pogo Producing Company for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying Section 24, Township 20 South, Range 26 East, in the following manner: All of the section for all pools or formations developed on 640-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the McMillan-Morrow Gas Pool; the S/2 of the section for all pools or formations developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Undesignated McMillan-Cisco Gas Pool and the Undesignated Northeast Springs-Strawn Gas Pool; the SE/4 of the section for all pools or formations developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent; and the SE/4 SE/4 of the section for all pools or formations developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The units are to be dedicated to the McMillan State "24" Well No. 1, to be drilled at an orthodox location 660 feet from the South and East lines of Section 24. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The units are located approximately 5½ miles southeast of Seven Rivers, New Mexico.
