Dear Sir/Madam,

A recent administrative law decision from the New Mexico Environment Department has eliminated the option of disposing of certain oil and gas exploration, production, transportation and refining wastes. No wastes identified as oil and gas wastes, except "domestic" oil and gas wastes will be allowed to be disposed in any solid waste facility authorized under the Solid Waste Act, NMSA 1978, §§74-9-1 through 42. Domestic waste is household type waste. The effective date of the decision is December 18, 2000.

If it has been your practice to accept such wastes, this letter shall serve as your official notice to cease such activity. Failure to comply with this notice may result in enforcement actions, which may include the assessment of monetary penalties.
