Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the following described spacing and proration unit in Section 26, Township 18 South, Range 24 East as follows: the S/2 for all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Undesignated Penasco Draw-Morrow Gas Pool and the Undesignated Penasco Draw-Permo Pennsylvanian Gas Pool. Said unit is to be dedicated to applicant's Poco Mesa "26" State Com Well No. 1 to be drilled at an unorthodox location (administrative approval pending) 1980 feet from the South line and 2400 feet from the West line (Unit K) of said Section 26 to a depth sufficient to test all formations from the surface to the base of the Pennsylvanian formation.
