Dear Mr. Stogner:

On Tuesday, October 9, I filed the above-referenced case with the Division, requesting that the case be set for hearing on the November 1, 2001 Examiner Docket. You and I discussed this case several times in the last two months.

You will recall that we discussed filing this case as an administrative application. I had planned to bring in the administrative application and review it with you before filing it to ensure that it was complete and that it contained enough information so that you could consider the merits of the case without requiring a hearing. You indicated, but did not commit to me, that the case would probably be appropriate for filing as an administrative application. Upon filing, you indicated that, depending on the merits of the information submitted with the application, the case would probably be appropriately set for hearing, but advertised with the provision that "in the absence of objection, this matter will be taken under advisement." The reason the case may be appropriate for docketing with the "in the absence of objection" language is that the requested relief is in accordance with statewide rules.

Unfortunately, I was not able to obtain the technical information to discuss it with you before you were out of the office earlier this week. Therefore, I filed the case as a formal application to ensure that it would be set for the November 1, 2001 docket.

In support of the application, enclosed please find the technical information developed by my client. Please review this information and let me know whether it is sufficient for the Division to consider the merits of the application without requiring a formal presentation at the November 1


