STATEMENT OF THE CASE

1. Tmbr/Sharp has the right to drill and develop the oil and gas minerals from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying W/2 of Section 10, T14S, R34E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. Tmbr/Sharp had drill its tmber "10" State Well No. 1 is on unorthodox gas well location 2630 feet from the South line and 713 feet from the West line this section.

3. The well is subject to the rules for the East Saunders Permo-Penn Pool which together for 160-acre spacing.

4. Tmbr/Sharp proposed to dedicated this well to a non-standard unit consisting of the S/4NW/4 and the N/2 of the SW/4 of Section 10.

5. The proposed unorthodox well location encroaches towards Lot 12 and 13 and is necessary for a geologic reasons.

6. W/2 of Section 10 have common ownership for all categories of owners and therefore there are no correlative rights adversely affected by this location.
