

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Case 12882: Application of Nadel and Gussman Permian, L.L.C. for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to 200 feet below the top of the Mississippian formation underlying the following described acreage in Section 26, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, and in the following manner: The E $\frac{1}{2}$ to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including but not limited to the Undesignated North Turkey Track-Cisco Gas Pool, Undesignated North Turkey Track-Atoka Gas Pool, and North Turkey Track-Morrow Gas Pool; the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ to form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 160-acre spacing within that vertical extent; the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ to form a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 80-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including but not limited to the Undesignated Travis-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool; and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 40-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including but not limited to the Artesia Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool, Undesignated East Illinois Camp-Bone Spring Pool, and the Undesignated Southwest Palmillo-Bone Spring Pool. The units are to be dedicated to applicant's Mission State Com. Well No. 1, to be drilled at an orthodox location in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ (Unit B) of Section 26. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The units are located approximately 12 miles southwest of Loco Hills, New Mexico.

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
