Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in all formations from the surface to the base of the Strawn formation in the S/2 SW/4 of Section 10, Township 17 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico for all formations and/or pools developed on 80-acre

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spacing which includes but is not necessarily limited to the Undesignated Humble City-Strawn Pool and the Undesignated Shipp-Strawn Pool. Said unit is to be dedicated to its Voyager (Shipp #1-4 Well, a re-entry of the Hanley Shipp #1 Well, at a surface location 990 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the West line and directionally drilled to an unorthodox bottomhole location 860 feet from the South line and 1400 feet from the West line of said Section 10 to a depth sufficient to test all formations from the surface to the base of the Strawn formation. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, provisions governing subsequent operations on the pooled units, designation of Nearburg Producing Company as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 7 miles Southeast of Lovington, New Mexico.
