Ladies and Gentlemen:

You are hereby notified that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division has filed the referenced Application, a copy of which is enclosed herewith, seeking an order requiring you to bring your West Fork Federal Unit Well No. 4 in Chaves County, New Mexico into compliance with Division Rule 201.B, by either restoring said well to production or beneficial use, permanently plugging and abandoning or temporarily abandoning same. In addition, the Division seeks assessment of civil penalties for your failure to comply with previous administrative notices to bring this well into compliance.

A hearing on this Application will take place before a Division hearing officer on Thursday, August 1, 2002, at 8:15 a.m., in the Division Hearing Room, First Floor, 1220 South St. Francis Drive in Santa Fe, New Mexico. At that hearing you will have an opportunity to show cause, if any there be, why an order should not be entered as requested in the Application. **The Division will not seek assessment of a penalty if your well is in full compliance on or before the day of the hearing.**
