12 the Application of EOG Resources for simultaneous
13 dedication, Eddy County, New Mexico. This case is also
14 continued to February 20th, 2003.

15 Page 2, Case Number 12,977 is the Application of
16 McElvain Oil and Gas Properties, Inc., for compulsory
17 pooling, San Juan County, New Mexico. This case is
18 dismissed.

19 Case 12,967 and Case 12,968, these are both
20 Applications of BP America Production Company for surface
21 commingling, Eddy County, New Mexico. These cases were
22 heard by David Catanach some time ago and were continued
23 from January 9th to today's docket. They are again
24 continued to March 13th. Both cases, 12,967 and 12,968,
25 are again continued to March 13th.

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Case Number 13,004, this is the Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division through the Environmental Bureau Chief for an order determining the reasonable -- I'm sorry, the responsible parties or party and ordering these parties to conduct Division-approved corrective action with respect to hydrocarbon releases in Lea County, New Mexico. This case will be continued to the March 13th, hearing.


