
Dear Ms. Wrotenbery:

This letter is to advise the Division that Yates Petroleum Corporation will not use the Archimedes "ARE" State Well No. 1 (**API No. 30-015-10414**) for injection into the Canyon formation and therefore has no objection to Marathon's application to vacate Order SWD-852.

Division Order SWD-814, dated October 3, 2001 and extended by the Division through April 3, 2003, previously granted the application of Yates Petroleum Corporation for authority to convert its Archimedes "ARE" State Well No. 1 to a salt water disposal well in the Devonian formation through an injection interval from approximately 10,600 feet to 10,800 feet. Due to the concerns of Marathon Oil Company, Yates will convert this well for disposal into only the Devonian formation pursuant to order SWD-814.
