I am in-house counsel for Occidental Permian Ltd. ("Oxy"). Oxy's outside counsel, Thomas Kellahin, is currently out of the country, so I am responding to the above-referenced Order of the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") on behalf of Oxy.

It is Oxy's position that nothing in Paragraph 9 of the subject Stipulated Conditional Dismissal nor any other provision of that document restricts the Division's ability to use information obtained from the results of the proposed site investigation to determine any party's responsibility for the hydrocarbon release at issue. In other words, the Stipulated Conditional Dismissal does not affect whatever authority the Division otherwise would have to use such data to determine liability in this matter.
