

My dear Herman:

The Two States Oil Company desires a special location in the SE SE, Sec. 21-188-38E, which special location is closer than 330 ft. to the line, and in order for the Commission to grant an exception to that rule, a Formal Petition before the Commission is necessary in order that the Commission may have something upon which to act. There should be filed with the Commission an Application for such special spacing with the statement of the necessity, therefor.

Informally, it is understood that the necessity for this special location is due to the right-of-way of the T & P Railroad, and the right-of-way of a Federal Highway. The Commission is in session today, so date your Formal Application, Santa Fe, New Mexico, September 16th. The Summons for Hearing, at 9:00 A.M., October 5, at Santa Fe, is being drawn today, September 16th. This is to be published both in Lea County and Santa Fe, the means of service provided for by law.

At the hearing you will present your testimony in support of this Petition. Anyone having any objection to your Petition has opportunity to be heard. The Commission then enters its order, based upon the evidence.
