


TO THE NEW MEXICO OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION



TO SAID HONORABLE COMMISSION

Now comes J. P. Cusack, of Midland Texas and makes this petition for permission from said Honorable Commission to permit him to drill a well for Oil and Gas purposes on the following described land, to wit;

East one-half of the South East one-fourth of Section thirty four, Township eighteen South, Range thirty eight East, Lea County, New Mexico.

Petitioner asks to locate said well 1000 feet south of the North line and 130 feet east of the West line of the above described property.

Petitioner desires to make the location as above set forth because the above described property is sub-divided into town lots and there are buildings erected thereon, and because of residences and a school building being erected on and adjacent thereto the location requested is the best location from a stand point of safety.

WHEREFORE your petitioner requests the Honorable Conservation Commission to consider this request and on its hearing he be granted a permit to make the location for an Oil well as hereinabove set forth.
