In reply to your letter of February 28, with regard to the above captioned wells, it is suggested that you take the matter up direct with Mr. H.L. Williams, whose address is Prescott, Arizona.

The removal of the casing by salvage by parties in part represented by Mr. Rhoads of Borger, Texas, was a matter of hearing before the Commission a few years ago. The Commission denied Nipper and Finkelstein, applicants, permission to remove the casing from two of the H.L. Williams wells. The applicants then took the matter to the District Court at Gallup, and as I recall, was disposed of by the state upon demurrer. That being the last information in the writer's files upon the matter.
