

**ORDER OF PROCEDURE TO CONSIDER
WHETHER OR NOT TO CONTINUE
SHUTDOWN BEYOND SEPTEMBER 1.**

1. GOVERNOR MILES OPENS MEETING AND MAKES SUCH REMARKS AS HE DEEMS APPROPRIATE.
2. COMMISSIONER WORDEN ORDERS READING OF NOTICE OF HEARING.
3. WHEN READING OF NOTICE IS FINISHED, COMMISSIONER WORDEN ANNOUNCES THAT THE COMMISSION IS READY TO PROCEED.
4. IF ANY WITNESSES ARE OFFERED, COMMISSIONER WORDEN SWEARS THEM IN.
5. IF THERE IS NO TESTIMONY FOR FURTHER CONTINUANCE OF SHUT-DOWN, THE COMMISSION ANNOUNCES THROUGH COMMISSIONER WORDEN THAT THE COMMISSION WILL ENTERTAIN AN ORAL COURT MOTION FOR DISMISSAL OF CASE 18.
6. IF ORAL COURT MOTION TO DISMISS IS MADE, COMMISSION MEMBERS CONSULT EACH OTHER AND ANNOUNCE THEIR DECISION, IN CASE THEY HAVE REACHED A DECISION.
7. IF DECISION IS REACHED, FORMAL ORDER OF COMMISSION'S DECISION IS IMMEDIATELY PREPARED AND SUBMITTED TO COMMISSION FOR EXECUTION.
8. COMMISSION ADJOURNS MEETING ON CASE 18 AND THEN CONVENES FOR PURPOSE OF FIXING ALLOWABLE FOR SEPTEMBER.
