

Gentlemen:

The writer is profoundly grateful to you for your letter of May 27 enclosing tear sheet showing that the Notice in the above captioned case was in fact published on May 7; however, the publisher's Proof of Publication, signed by Mr. A. L. Bert under oath, states that the said Notice was published May 14, which Proof of Publication is herewith returned.

The confusion did not occur, as you stated, by reason of this department's directing the letter of transmittal with Notice for Publication to Mr. A. L. Bert, for said letter of transmittal dated April 30 was to the Artesia Advocate, copy of which letter is enclosed for your information.

The "Proof" of Publication which turned out to be erroneous as to date of publication did not arrive until about the time set for the hearing. Insofar as the publication in the Artesia paper was concerned the Commission could not rely upon the publication in your paper for service as provided by law by reason of the fact that said Proof of Publication stated that the Notice was published May 14, just 4 days before the hearing. You can, therefore, readily see the confusion that has transpired.




