

Gentlemen:

Please refer to Case No. 102, Order No. 719, Petition of American Employers' Insurance Company for an order directed to San Juan Oil and Gas Company to show cause why a well located in San Juan County, New Mexico, in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, should not be declared abandoned and ordered plugged.

The Order heretofore entered in this case gave until January 1st, 1948, for the completion of the plugging of the well.

A great deal of difficulty has been experienced by the American Employers' Insurance Company in locating the principals and its indemnitors in this case. Although they have now been located, it will be impossible to have the plugging operation completed by January 1st, 1948.

For the foregoing reason, it is respectfully requested that the time for plugging this well be extended until the 15th day of February, 1948.
