ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter came on regularly for hearing at 10:00 o'clock A.M. at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico herein-after referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 3rd day of May, 1948, the Commission having before it for consideration the testimony adduced at the hearing of said cause and being fully advised in the premises;

FINDS:

1. That proper public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause;
2. That there has been no objection to the proposed recommendations of the New Mexico Nomenclature Committee as submitted to the Commission and the Commission having no objections.
3. That production of the Red Lake pool, for identification purposes, should be considered as from the Grayburg - San Andreas formation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That Red Lake pool production hereafter shall be identified as production from the Grayburg - San Andreas formation.
2. That the S/2 of Section 24, and all of Section 25 in Township 17 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M. from which production is had from the Yates-Seven Rivers formation is hereby deleted from said Red Lake pool, and the description of said Red Lake pool in Order No. 633, is hereby amended accordingly.
