Gentlemen:

When I talked to Mr. Frank Bestal on Ostober 18, he told me that he would have a bond up on the Bestal well in Otero County within two or three days. It will be necessary to get the approval of the Oil Conservation Commission before plugging the well.

I should like you to note that the State law provides a penalty for drilling a well without an approved form C-101. I should like to call your attention to the first paragraph an page 17 in the enclosed pamphlet.
